**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2893 waives the requirement for paraprofessionals seeking teacher certification to take additional coursework if they have a college degree in education and have not been out of the classroom for more than 10 years.

Further, the measure waives the requirement for any emergency certified, alternatively certified, or standard certified teacher to complete additional coursework if they have a bachelor's degree in education and have not been out of the classroom for more than 10 years.
