In its current form, HB2894 extends the sunset date for the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act. This measure is not expected to impact state revenue.

**ANALYSIS:** This measure amends 68 O.S. § 2397 of the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act by extending the Act's sunset date from January 1, 2026, to January 1, 2032.<sup>1</sup> No revenue impacts are anticipated following this proposal, as the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act includes revenue-neutral provisions.
