**Research Analysis**

HB 2895, as introduced, amends the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act to provide that Directors have 60 days to appoint a probationary master teacher. Additionally, in determining the number of required master teachers based on licensed capacity and desired Star level, after school care children will not be counted towards the license capacity.

**Fiscal Analysis**

As introduced, HB2895 provides that directors of full-time child care centers have sixty days to appoint a probationary master teacher. The measure also indicates that after school children shall not be counted when determining the number of required master teachers.

This measure is not expected to impact state revenue or state appropriations.
