Fiscal Analysis

HJR 1002 amends Article 5, § 3 of the Oklahoma Constitution by removing the Governor's ability to set special election dates for referred measures. The measure does not mandate any expenditure by a state agency, and any required changes to process at the agency level are expected to be absorbable through existing agency resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
