## **Fiscal Analysis**

HJR 1013 amends Article 5 § 3 and Article 24 § 2 of the Oklahoma Constitution. The measure raises the voting requirements to amend the Oklahoma Constitution by requiring sixty percent (60%) of each legislative house rather than a majority vote. The new voting requirements would apply both to amendments proposed pursuant to initiative petitions and to proposals submitted to the people by the Legislature. The measure does not mandate any expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
