**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 1019 prohibits any insurer from establishing, implementing, or enforcing any policy, practice, or procedure which imposes a time limit on the amount of covered anesthesia services provided during a medical or surgical procedure or restricting or excluding coverage or payment of anesthesia time.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1019 prohibits insurers from imposing time limits on the amount of covered anesthesia services provided during procedures, and from excluding coverage or restricting payment for anesthesia time. In its current form, SB 1019 is not expected to impact the state HealthChoice plan, and therefore is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
