**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 1050 modifies the time limits for insurers and health care providers to request refunds on paid claims. Insurers now have six months, reduced from 12 months, and health care providers have 12 months, reduced from 18 months, to make these requests after a claim is paid out.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Engrossed version of SB1050 decreases the amount of time during which an insurance company may request a refund from the claimant. In its current form, this measure is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
