**Research Analysis**

SB 2 requires wind energy facilities constructed after November 1, 2025 to be:

- 1/4 nautical mile away from a residential dwelling; and
- 1/4 nautical mile away from the nearest point of any nonparticipating property.

Any wind energy facility that has filed a notice of commencement of construction prior to November 1, 2025, and plans to start construction before November 1, 2026, is exempt from the setback requirements.
