Research Analysis

SB 382 requires children to be potty trained before enrolling in pre-k. Parents are required to complete a form assuring the school district that their child is potty trained. Children with disabilities would be exempt.

The measure requires the State Department of Education to create a process for schools to follow when a child is enrolled, but is *not potty trained*, which is defined in the measure.

Such a child may be temporarily unenrolled until they are fully trained. A school could also refer the parents to potty training resources or allow the parent to aid in the training as needed.
