**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 694 prohibits municipal territory from being detached if it: includes an intervening strip less than four rods wide; is separated from corporate limits of a municipality only by a railway right-of-way; is a highway right-of-way adjacent to or contiguous with a municipality; or includes properties that will be split in two. The measure allows the state, county, political subdivision, or governmental entity that would assume responsibility over the proposed detached territory to give written consent.
