Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 970 provides that a custodial parent under a court order must receive notice from the noncustodial parent or a representative if the noncustodial parent is unable to comply with court-ordered visitation or other requirements because they are receiving in-patient treatment within the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services or at a certified facility.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 970 requires noncustodial parents, or their representative, to provide notice to the custodial parent if they are unable to comply with court-ordered visitation or any other court-ordered requirement due to receiving in-patient treatment at a facility within the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.

In its current form, SB 970 is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
