**Bill Analysis**

SB 1015 creates the State-Sponsored Persecution Prohibition Act. The measure prohibits any state agency, board, or commission from conducting investigations in a manner that maliciously harasses, terrorizes, punitively regulates, intimidates, or perturbs private businesses, farms, taxpayers, or citizens for personal, economic, political, or ideological reasons. The measure provides for civil action against any offending agency, board, or commission.
