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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1024 requires any agency seeking to promulgate or amend any emergency or permanent rule to prepare a statement that includes a description of the objective of the rule, a description of existing policies relating to the rule, the statutory authority to promulgate the rule, estimates of the amount of time that would be spent by state employees to develop the rule, a description of entities affected by the rule, and a summary of any existing or proposed federal regulation that is intended to address the activities to be regulated by the rule or rules proposed to be promulgated. The statement shall be presented to the Secretary of State, who shall determine whether the agency has the authority to promulgate the rule. The Secretary shall report the statement of scope and such determination to the Governor, who shall approve or reject the statement of scope. The agency shall not promulgate the rule until the Governor approves the statement. The statement shall also be submitted to the chairs of the Administrative Rules Committees of the Senate and the House. A statement of scope shall expire 30 months after the date on which it is published in "The Oklahoma Register".

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
