**Bill Analysis**

SB 1044 requires all payments made by a retail beer, retail wine, or retail spirits licensee to a beer distributor or a wine and spirits wholesaler licensee to be made by electronic funds transfer (EFT) payment. The measure requires the EFT payment transmittal to the banking institution to occur no later than the next banking business day from the date of the delivery. The measure authorizes wholesaler licensees to accept cash, check, or money orders in certain circumstances.
