Bill Analysis

SB 1046 creates a delivery services license for retailers, restaurants, clubs, grocery stores, convenience stores, and bars and the employees of such businesses. The measure establishes an annual fee of \$1,500.00 for the Delivery Service License for the businesses and \$30.00 for the Delivery Driver License. The measure provides that the actions of a driver or server shall not be attributable to the retailer, restaurant, club, grocery store, convenience store, and bar with regard to providing alcohol to a minor or delivery of alcohol into a dry area. The measure provides that a retailer, restaurant, bar, or club holding a mixed beverage, beer and wine, or caterer/mixed beverage license shall not be required to verify the delivery service licensee has received delivery driver training or a delivery driver license.
