**Bill Analysis**

SB 105 modifies the Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program. The measure modifies the purpose to provide certain scholarships to students with special needs. It modifies eligibility to remove the requirement that the student attend a public school district the year prior to applying for the program. It removes language stating that acceptance of a scholarship has the same effect as parental revocation of consent to services under certain provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
