Bill Analysis

SB 1055 provides for the automatic expungement of criminal records pertaining to nonviolent misdemeanors if at least 10 years have passed since the last conviction, the person has not been convicted of a felony, all fines and fees have been paid, and no felony or misdemeanor charges are pending against the person. The prosecuting and arresting agency may still petition the court for an order unsealing the records.
