**Bill Analysis**

SB 1066 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to create and maintain a registry of recommending physicians by January 1, 2026. The measure requires any physician recommending the use of medical marijuana to be registered with the Authority. The measure requires such physicians to comply with medical education and continuing medical education requirements relating to medical marijuana prior to registering. The measure authorizes the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, and the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners to consult with the Executive Director of the Authority to develop a list of medical marijuana courses.
