Bill Analysis

SB 1086 provides that the registration of a voter shall be cancelled if it is determined that the voter is not a citizen of the United States. The measure directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to compare the list of registered voters with the database of a relevant entity that maintains information regarding the citizenship of residents. Any person found on such a database who is classified as a noncitizen shall receive notice from the Secretary. The voter shall have 30 days from the date of receipt of the notice to present proof of citizenship. Such proof shall be the same requirements for proof of citizenship when obtaining a Real ID. The voter shall be referred to the appropriate district attorney and have his or her registration cancelled if proof is not presented. Additionally, the measure requires any person accessing the voter registration list to complete an application form approved by the Secretary.
