**Bill Analysis**

SB 1100 directs the court sentencing a defendant convicted of domestic abuse to a suspended or deferred sentence to require the defendant to participate in a batterers' intervention program certified by the Attorney General. Alternative batterers' intervention programs shall also be certified by the Attorney General and require at least 26 weeks to complete the program.
