**Bill Analysis**

SB 1118 establishes a retirement age of 75 for each Justice of the Supreme Court, a Judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals or of the Court of Civil Appeals, and district or associate district court judge. Each affected person may choose to complete his or her term prior to retiring. Affected persons who reached the age of 75 prior to the effective date of this measure shall retire unless they choose to complete their term. The measure provides that persons over the age of 75 shall not be eligible for election, retention, or appointment to any appellate or district court.
