Bill Analysis

SB 112 creates the categories of “residential journeyman plumber” and “unlimited journeyman plumber.” Residential journeyman plumbers shall only be authorized to work on detached one- or two-family dwellings. Applicants for a residential journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor examination shall hold an associate’s degree or vocational diploma certifying completion of a formal plumbing educational program approved by the Committee consisting of a minimum of 1,000 classroom hours, have at least 2 years of experience in the plumbing trade as well as 4 hours of continuing education, 2 years of experience in the plumbing trade while serving in the United States Armed Forces as well as 6 hours of continuing education, or a current out-of-state plumbing license. Applicants for an unlimited journeyman plumber examination shall hold an associate’s degree or vocational diploma certifying completion of a formal plumbing educational program approved by the Committee consisting of a minimum of 1,000 classroom hours, have at least 3 years of experience in the plumbing trade and 6 hours of continuing education, 3 years of experience in the plumbing trade while serving in the United States Armed Forces, or a current out-of-state plumbing license.
