Bill Analysis

SB 1123 directs the Attorney General to determine if a municipality is obstructing the federal government from the enforcement of immigration law, knowingly aiding or abetting any individual in furtherance of a violation of any immigration law, or declaring itself a sanctuary city. If the Attorney General determines the city is in violation of these provisions, the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be notified and shall place all sales and lodging taxes collected on behalf of the municipality in an agency special account. The money shall continue to be placed in the account until the Attorney General notifies the Commission that the municipality is complying with the provisions of this measure.
