**Bill Analysis**

SB 130 directs the Corporation Commission to submit a requisition to contract with an outside firm to conduct a technical and legal feasibility study on nuclear energy generation within 30 days of the effective date. If price, fitness, availability, and quality are otherwise equal, preference shall be given to consulting firms with at least 40% their assets owned by 1 or more military veterans. The Commission shall coordinate with retail electric suppliers and municipally owned electric utilities to provide relevant information to the study. The study's finding shall be submitted to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor no more than 9 months after the effective date. The measure appropriates \$375,000.00 to the Commission to perform the feasibility study.
