**Bill Analysis**

SB 16 creates the Oklahoma Second Amendment Financial Privacy Act. The measure prohibits any government entity from knowingly keeping any list or record of privately owned firearms or the owners of those firearms. The measure also prohibits any payment card network from requiring or incentivizing the use of a merchant category code in a manner that distinguishes a firearm retailer from other retailers. The measure directs the Attorney General to investigate reasonable allegations that a person or entity violated the provisions of this measure. Any person or entity found to have violated the provisions of this measure shall receive written notice from the Attorney General and cease such actions within 30 days of receiving the notice. If a court finds a person or entity to have violated these provisions, it shall enjoin such a person or entity from continuing such activity. A person or entity that continues to violate the provisions of this measure shall be subject to a \$1,000.00 civil penalty per violation.
