**Bill Analysis**

SB 171 directs the Department of Public Safety to create a security plan for the Oklahoma State Capitol and to update the plan every 3 years. The measure also creates within the Legislative Service Bureau the position of Capitol Liaison to the State Capitol Preservation Commission. Proposals for enhancement, modification, preservation, or restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol and Oklahoma State Capitol grounds shall be submitted to the Liaison. The Capitol Liaison shall be the primary liaison for all tenants that occupy space in the Oklahoma State Capitol. The measure eliminates the State Capitol Repair Expenditure Oversight Committee. Additionally, the measure modifies the membership of the State Capitol Preservation Commission. The measure provides that the chairmanship of the Commission shall rotate between the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House.
