**Bill Analysis**

SB 173 modifies apportionments made from Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act revenues to the Rebuilding Oklahoma Access and Driver Safety Fund. The measure apportions monies that would otherwise be apportioned to the Fund to the newly created Municipal Improvements for Roads and Bridges Fund. Monies from the Fund shall be evenly distributed to the Transportation Commission districts to construct and maintain municipal roads and bridges. Municipalities are authorized to accumulate monies from the Fund for a period of 5 years to fund specific projects. The bill further directs the Transportation Commission to promulgate rules and develop the criteria for determining the level of priority for proposed projects, and include the projects in an annually-updated 5 year plan.
