**Bill Analysis**

SB 208 prohibits any resident or nonresident from assisting persons in the taking of game for compensation or other consideration in this state without first obtaining a hunting guide license. The measure establishes an annual fee of \$1,000.00 for the license for residents and \$2,000.00 for nonresidents. Applicants must demonstrate they have a driver license, can provide lifesaving first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation, produce liability coverage equal to \$1 million, and obtain written permission from the landowner and possess such document while hunting. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this measure shall be subject to a fine no less than 5 times the amount of the annual fee and 10 times the amount of the annual fee for subsequent violations.
