Bill Analysis

SB 209 creates the Southeast Asia Trade Office within the State Department of Commerce. The Office shall facilitate economic relationships between Oklahoma-based businesses and business entities with principal business activity which is based or occurs in southeast Asia, promote Oklahoma businesses, facilitate positive relationships between the state and relevant government entities, coordinate with relevant entities for business outreach, and actions taking place at the federal level. The Office shall maintain a physical office in Taipei, Taiwan.
