Bill Analysis

SB 245 directs the State Department of Education to establish and maintain the Oklahoma High Dosage Tutoring Program. The measure provides bonus amounts to be provided to high dosage tutors employed or contracted by public school districts based on each cohort they educate and increases in academic grade levels. It states that if a high dosage tutor fails to achieve a certain level of growth, he or she will be placed on 1-year probation as a participant, and if he or she fails to achieve a certain level of growth while on probation, he or she loses participation eligibility. The bill also creates the High Dosage Tutoring Revolving Fund.
