Bill Analysis

SB 278 directs the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to create and administer a program to provide living survivors of the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre with a payment of \$2 million from the newly created Tulsa Race Massacre Victims' Compensation Revolving Fund. The program shall be developed in coordination with the assistance of nonprofit organizations and relevant political subdivisions. If a survivor dies prior to receipt of such payment, payment shall be made to legatees as designated in a will of such survivor, or to the descendants of the survivor. Payments made to such individuals shall not cumulatively exceed \$2 million. The measure appropriates \$4 million to the Fund from the General Revenue Fund.
