**Bill Analysis**

SB 37 authorizes the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to respond to a mass casualty event without a request from a law enforcement agency and coordinate with local law enforcement agencies that are responding to the event. A mass casualty event is defined as an event that results in no less than 3 injured individuals, that requires more emergency response resources than are typically available in the jurisdiction, and results in a sudden and timely surge of injured individuals in need of emergency services. The measure also creates the Mass Casualty Revolving Fund.
