Bill Analysis

SB 388 allows students enrolled in charter schools and virtual charter schools to be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities offered by the student's resident school district. The measure directs eligibility for such activities to be determined in accordance with the resident districts' eligibility rules and policies. It also modifies the Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act to require that a school athletic association of which school districts are members to adopt a policy that requires a student enrolled in a charter or virtual charter school to be able to participate in interscholastic activities or contests.
