Bill Analysis

SB 437 provides that an original or certified copy of an applicant's birth certificate shall qualify as primary proof of identity as it relates to applying for a driver license. Any birth certificate issued by a county shall not qualify as primary proof of identity. Employees of Service Oklahoma who accept a county issued birth certificate shall be suspended for 30 days without pay on the first instance and lose his or her employment on the second instance. Any employee who instructs another employee to accept such certification shall lose his or her employment.
