## **Bill Analysis**

SB 461 requires any prosecuting individual maintaining a Brady-Giglio list to adopt a policy listing the criteria to be placed on such a list, provide notice to the officer prior to placing him or her on the list, allow the officer with the right to provide input prior to being placed on the list, allow the officer to request the prosecuting individual to reconsider the placement, and show the applicable time frame and procedures for notifying the officer of the final decision. A Brady-Giglio list is a list compiled by a prosecuting individual that contains the names and details of officers who have sustained incidents of untruthfulness, criminal convictions, candor issues, or some other type of issue which places the credibility of the officer into question. A request for reconsideration shall be made within 30 days of receiving the notice. Any officer placed on such a list prior to the effective date of this measure may request reconsideration. Any prosecutor maintaining such a list prior to the effective date of this measure shall send notice to each officer on the list within 30 days of the effective date.
