**Bill Analysis**

SB 462 authorizes retiring municipal police officers to request to retain their municipal-issued firearm and badge. The request shall be denied only if the officer is not in good standing, the officer has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude, the officer is mentally incapacitated, or if good cause is shown that granting the request is detrimental to public health and safety. Upon the death of the officer, the municipal law enforcement agency may award the gun and badge to the next of kin.
