Bill Analysis

SB 478 provides that a landowner, agricultural lessee, or his or her designated agent with written permission from the landowner or agricultural lessee may control nuisance or damage by feral swine without a permit during the day or night. During the regular deer gun season, any person who is not a landowner hunting on his or her land shall be required to possess a hunting license and deer gun license to hunt such swine. The measure provides for automatic revocation of a person's hunting license for the discharge of a firearm from a public roadway. The measure also repeals a provision of law providing for the permitting of private property owners to kill feral swine.
