Bill Analysis

SB 481 prohibits any public employee whose salary is paid by taxpayer dollars from speaking or participating in a matter of public concern deemed a matter of larger societal significance or importance during the employee's work hours unless he or she uses annual leave. No public employee may use assets or equipment owned by the state, a political subdivision, or a school district outside the scope of his or her employment.
