Bill Analysis

SB 5 modifies the duties of the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency. The measure directs the Office to establish a division that shall review proposed and current administrative rules. The newly established division shall evaluate whether:

- 1) proposed rules comply with the provisions of the Oklahoma Constitution,
- 2) proposed rules fulfill legislative intent,
- 3) proposed rules shall have a disproportionate negative impact, and
- 4) the proposing agency has statutory authority to promulgate the rule.

The division shall not employ more than 5 FTE's and shall issue a report on the information described above to the Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, or the Administrative Rules Committee chairs of the Senate or the House. The Pro Tempore, Speaker, and committee chairs of the Administrative Rules Committee may also direct the division to conduct evaluations of existing provisions of the administrative code.
