**Bill Analysis**

SB 524 authorizes the concealed carry of a firearm for any person who is 21 years of age or older as well as members of the armed forces who are at least 18 years of age at an election day polling location or in-person absentee voting location. Such a person may not carry a firearm to a polling place if it is located in a school unless person possesses a valid Oklahoma Self-Defense Act license. The measure provides liability immunity to the state and county election board for any actions arising from any action or misconduct with a firearm committed by a person at an election day polling location or in-person absentee voting location.
