**Bill Analysis**

SB 555 creates the Education Regulatory Sandbox Program. The measure authorizes a school district to submit an application for an exemption from a specific education-related statutory requirement or an administrative rule in exchange for the school district implementing an innovation intended to improve educational outcomes. It allows the exemption to be granted for 3 years. The bill requires school districts that are granted exemptions to submit annual progress reports. It allows a school district to apply for a 3-year renewal of the exemption. It also requires the State Department of education to submit a report on the program to the Governor and legislative leaders after 3 years.
