**Bill Analysis**

SB 636 prohibits any state entity or political subdivision from using public funding to distribute any pamphlet or kit that opposes the rights granted by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment. The measure also prohibits such entities from employing any liaison or lobbyist to support or defeat the enactment, repeal, or amendment of any legislation, rule, regulation, administrative action, or order by any federal or state governmental entity relating to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment. Public funding for actions relating to advocating against such rights is also prohibited. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to elected officials, persons presenting neutral testimony, or any person stating a personal opinion while presenting testimony.
