**Bill Analysis**

SB 659 creates the Voter Registration Integrity Act. The measure prohibits any state agency from providing voter registration materials to any individual without first verifying that the individual is a legal citizen and resident of this state. Individuals who knowingly violate this prohibition shall be subject to a maximum fine of \$5,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. The measure requires each state agency that processes voter registration materials to submit an annual compliance report to the State Election Board no later than January 31 of each year for the preceding year.
