**Bill Analysis**

SB 660 creates the Oklahoma Foreign Agents Registration Act. The measure requires any person acting as an agent of a foreign principal from a country of particular concern to register with the Attorney General. Such a person must file a registration with the Attorney General within 10 days of becoming such an agent. The measure excludes certain forms of media from this requirement. The registration shall include a comprehensive statement of the nature of the registrant's business as well as the nature and number of contributions, income, money, or thing of value the registrant has received in the last 180 days. A supplement to the registration shall be submitted within 6 months of the filing along with an oath affirming that the information provided is full and complete. The measure shall retroactively apply to any person who acted as an agent beginning January 1, 2014. Such agents shall be required to disclose the nature of any materials they distribute on behalf of a foreign principal. The Attorney General shall report information relating to the enforcement of this measure to the Legislature every 6 months.
