Bill Analysis

SB 707 modifies language regarding school accreditation. It directs the State Board of Education to adopt standards for the accreditation of school districts, rather than school sites. The bill modifies language regarding a 4-year accreditation cycle. It requires evaluations of school districts beginning in the 2025-2026 school year to be conducted every 4 years, and it removes language allowing the Board to interrupt the four-year cycle for certain reasons.
