Bill Analysis

SB 733 requires an indictment or information to be filed by the state within 5 business days of an arrest if the person is held in custody after the arrest. In counties with a population greater than 500,000, the indictment or information shall be filed within 10 days. If the deadline passes without an indictment or information being filed, the person held shall be released subject to an own recognizance bond. The measure authorizes an arrested person may move for release on his or her own recognizance upon the expiration of the period to file an indictment or information even if the arrested person has already had bail set by the court.
