**Bill Analysis**

SB 737 provides that “supervision” as it relates to the provisions of the Interventional Pain Management and Treatment Act shall require that the supervising physician is present in the office before, during, and after the procedure and includes the authorization and evaluation of the procedure, ensuring that the patient-physician relationship remains intact.
