Bill Analysis

SB 745 extends from 26 to 30 the oldest age an individual can be to be given the opportunity to complete high school. It states that, beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, individuals between the ages of 21 and 30 shall only be eligible to complete high school if they attend a full-time virtual education program. It also excludes such individuals from being included in the calculation of a school's A-F report card.
