Bill Analysis

SB 792 modifies the School Safety and Bullying Prevention Act. The measure requires school districts' bullying policies to recognize the fundamental right of every student to take reasonable actions to defend himself or herself. It also requires policies governing investigation of reported incidents of bullying or threatening behavior to include a statement that the district does not have a zero-tolerance policy and a statement relating to students who engage in self defense.
