Bill Analysis

SB 798 provides specific reasons for which a teacher's license or certificate can be revoked or suspended by the State Board of Education. The measure prohibits the Board from having the authority to summarily revoke or suspend a certificate pending an individual proceeding for revocation or other action unless a valid emergency exists. It also prohibits the Board from taking such action unless the certificate holder and the employing school district have received notice at least 10 days prior to filing a complaint
